

Belle Terre House Rules

We want your stay at Belle Terre to be peaceful, relaxing, and respectful of the natural surroundings. Please take a moment to review our guidelines:

A Place for Quiet Enjoyment

- Belle Terre is designed for tranquility and is **not suitable for young children. We recommend ages 12 and up.**
- Please **limit to 1 car per cabin.**

Bringing a Boat or Watercraft?

- Limited parking is available. If you plan to bring a boat or watercraft, **please let us know in advance.** A **\$25 parking fee** applies.

Respect Neighboring Cabins

- You're welcome to **explore the property and woods**, but please **stay at least 150 feet from other cabins** to respect guest privacy.
- We're creating walking paths, but the forest is already beautiful and accessible—**explore responsibly.**

Noise Policy

- **No yelling, loud music, or disruptive noise at any time.**
- Please keep voices low between **10 PM and 8 AM** (extended to **11 PM on Fridays and Saturdays**).

Unplug & Reconnect with Nature

- Belle Terre offers an opportunity for a **digital detox experience**: there are **no TVs or WiFi in Maple and Frenchie. There are TV's in Luna and Forêt**, for which you can use your hotspot. Most cell carriers have good coverage for personal hotspots if needed.

Bringing Your Dog?

- We welcome **one dog per cabin**. Please **keep them off the beds**—If you know your dog will be sleeping in the bed with you, please let us know in advance so that we can prepare your cabin with our pet linen package, which includes a designated duvet cover and dog blanket. The pet linen package is **\$100**. **A \$150 fee applies** if this rule isn't followed.
- Be sure to **include your dog in your reservation** so that the **\$45 dog fee** is added to your reservation and we can provide a dog bed and bowls.
- Please **clean up after your dog and never leave them unattended inside the cabin**.

Smoking Policy

- **Absolutely no smoking inside the cabins.**
- You're welcome to smoke outdoors—please use the provided canisters to dispose of cigarette butts responsibly.

Firepits & Firewood

- We provide a **starter bundle of firewood** for your private Solo Stove firepit.
- Feel free to **gather fallen sticks (under 2" diameter) around your cabin** or purchase additional approved bundles on-site.
- For safety, **do not burn leaves or large logs** in the Solo Stove.
- Please note: **burn bans may occasionally restrict outdoor fires.**

Enjoy the Communal Firepit

- The communal firepit is **stocked with larger firewood and ready for all guests to enjoy!**

- **Please leave the bed unmade**
- **Remove any food from the fridge**
- **Wash your dirty dishes**
- **Take your trash to the black bin by the Red Barn**
